**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 5-C**

**EXTENDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROTOCOLS FOR QUARANTINE TO ALL PERSONS COMING FROM ALL CITIES AND COUNTIES OF NORTH GYEONGSANG PROVINCE INCLUDING DAEGU CITY AND CHEONGDO COUNTY.**

**WHEREAS**, the global case count of the 2019 Novel Coronavirus Acute Respiratory Disease (COVID-2019) reported by the World Health Organization has continuously increased in South Korea, Japan, and Singapore;

**WHEREAS**, South Korea reported community transmission in Daegu City and North Gyeongsang Province while Japan has reported community transmission in Tokyo and Hokkaido;

**WHEREAS**, on February 26, 2020, Presidential spokesperson Salvador S. Panelo announced that travelers from North Gyeongsang Province of South Korea are now barred from entering the Philippines;

**WHEREAS**, there continues to be a clear and present danger presented by the COVID-2019 that warrants an immediate need for the implementation of measures to prevent its entry while establishing protocols for the quarantine of all persons coming from North Gyeongsang Province of South Korea;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, **GWENDOLYN F. GARCIA**, Governor of the Province of Cebu, hereby extend the implementation of the protocols for quarantine in my previous Executive Orders to all persons arriving in the Province of Cebu coming from all cities and counties of North Gyeongsang Province including Daegu City and Cheongdo County.

This Executive Order takes effect immediately.
