EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 5-D

**EXTENDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROTOCOLS FOR
QUARANTINE TO ALL PERSONS COMING FROM ITALY AND IRAN**

WHEREAS, the global case count of the 2019 Novel Coronavirus Acute Respiratory Disease (COVID-2019) reported by the World Health Organization has continuously increased in Italy (with 7,375 cases and 366 deaths) and Iran (with 6,566 cases and 194 deaths);

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2020, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Presidential Proclamation No. 922 declaring a state of public health emergency throughout the Philippines;

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, the Department of Health has confirmed ten (10) new cases of the COVID-2019 within the Philippines bringing the total number of confirmed cases to twenty (20);

WHEREAS, there continues to be a clear and present danger presented by the COVID-2019 that warrants an immediate need for the implementation of measures to prevent its entry while establishing protocols for the quarantine of all persons coming from Italy and Iran;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **GWENDOLYN F. GARCIA**, Governor of the Province of Cebu, hereby extend the implementation of the protocols for quarantine in my previous Executive Orders to all persons arriving in the Province of Cebu coming from Italy and Iran.

This Executive Order takes effect on March 11, 2020.
